PRINCIPLE:

The State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) requires proper reporting by grantees/subgrantees to provide integrity to the use of grant funds and Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs) and to provide program review.

POLICY:

- A. Grantees/subgrantees are required to submit proper financial reporting pursuant to SERC policy 8.5.
- B. LEPCs and grantees/subgrantees are required to submit reports of exercises conducted pursuant to SERC Policies 8.1 and 8.3.
- C. LEPCs and grantees/subgrantees are required to report on any additional information requested by the SERC on its behalf or on behalf of granting federal agencies to include, but not limited to, the annual information requested for the Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning (HMEP) grant final report.
- D. Failure to submit proper reports pursuant to this policy may jeopardize future funding from the SERC.
