  - a. BYLAWS COMMITTEE** – the Chair of the Committee or spokesperson will give an update since the last SERC meeting. The SERC will review suggested changes to the SERC Bylaws as recommended by the Bylaws Committee; possible action may include approving, with or without amendments, or denying the recommended changes.
  - b. LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE** – the Chair of the Committee or spokesperson will provide an update since the last SERC meeting. The SERC will review suggested changes to the SERC NRSs and NACs; possible action may include approving, with or without amendments, or denying the recommended changes. The following NRSs and/or NACs may be reviewed, including but not limited to:
    - 1. Nevada Revised Statutes**
      - a. NRS 459.735.1** – ‘General Fund’ being used and 459.735.5 – ‘Highway Fund’ being used. Is this a conflict?

- b. NRS 459.742.4 – does the SERC still do this and 459.742.8 – should ‘Division of Emergency Management’ be changed to ‘Department of Public Safety’?
- c. NRS 459.755 – add language allowing the SERC to establish regulations governing the use of contingency account funds to reimburse LEPCs for hazardous materials spill clean-up.
- d. NRS 459.773 – does the Fire Marshal still do this?

5. **REVIEW OF THE LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEES (LEPCs) CURRENTLY NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL AND SERC POLICIES (Discussion / For Possible Action)** – The SERC will review LEPCs currently not in compliance with Federal and SERC policies, to include but not limited to Exercise Reports, Bylaws, Agendas/Minutes, Publications and Financial Reports; possible action may include the SERC advising the LEPC of non-compliance resulting in suspension of any current unencumbered grant funds and the LEPC being ineligible for future grant funds until the program is deemed compliant. The following LEPCs compliance may be reviewed, including but not limited to; Churchill County LEPC, Clark County LEPC, Elko County LEPC, Humboldt County LEPC, Lincoln County LEPC, Lyon County LEPC, Mineral County LEPC, Storey County LEPC, Washoe County LEPC, White Pine County LEPC.
