LETTER OF PROMULGATION

To the Citizens of Carson City,

Hazardous materials, when properly controlled, are important in everyday life. Uncontrolled, they may cause injury, death, destruction, and lingering effects that may last for many years. To meet the risk, a concerted effort must be made to identify, locate, quantify, and have knowledge of the hazardous materials in Carson City. The routes and modes of transportation of these chemicals must also be known to assess the possible danger posed by these materials.

Emergency planning for hazardous material releases cannot be solved successfully by any one organization or group but must be accomplished through the cooperative efforts of local, state, and federal authorities working in cooperation with the private sector. Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-499) mandates that local jurisdictions develop a plan for the emergency response to accidental releases of hazardous materials. The results of this local planning effort are set forth in this Carson City Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Plan. This plan will include the study of the problem itself, the resources available to handle the problem, and the emergency procedures to follow in the case of a release.

This plan provides a starting point for hazardous materials incident preparedness and response efforts. To achieve an optimal reasonable level of preparedness for potential hazardous materials incidents, all emergency response agencies need to become familiar with its contents, train their personnel to meet these situations, and develop an agency specific plan to reinforce and amplify the operational area plan.

Like all emergency plans, this is a living document that will be revised and refined as we gain more knowledge about incidents and as new capabilities are developed to manage and mitigate the consequences. On-going efforts to build and enhance preparedness must include regular drills and exercises involving all agencies involved in an actual response. These drills and exercises, together with after-actions reports from actual HAZMAT incidents, will be evaluated to provide a basis for future updates of this plan.

ANNEX E: FIXED AND EXTREMELY HAZARDOUS FACILITIES

E.1 Fixed Facilities Overview

This portion examines potential hazards for facilities that have reported the presence in one or more extremely hazardous substances (EHS) in excess of the Threshold Planning Quantity (TPQ). The facilities were evaluated similarly through the use of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration computer model known as CAMEO-Computer Aided Management of Emergency Operations. CAMEO uses the air dispersion equations and release rate methodologies provided in the Technical Guide for Hazard Analysis (U.S. Environmental Protection Agency 1987), developed by the Environmental Protection Agency, Federal Emergency Management Agency, and Department of Transportation.

For each facility, use CAMEO to calculate an estimated screening zone to plan for or respond to various EHS releases, based on the following variables to produce maximum credible scenarios:

1. Quantity Released - The maximum quantity that could be released in from the largest vessel or interconnected vessels.
2. Rate of Release to Air - The total quantity of gas, a solid in powder form, or a solid in solution assumed to be released in 10 minutes.
3. Temperature - The data only for liquids and molten metals, depending on whether they are used at ambient temperature, near their boiling point, or at their melting point.
4. Meteorological Conditions - The atmospheric stability and wind speed.
5. Topography - The features on the earth's surface, including its physical relief and constructed objects on it.
6. Level of Concern - The concentration level of an EHS in the air, above which serious health effects might occur as a result of the single exposure for a relatively short period.

Note 1: These variables are complex. Release and dispersion methodologies may not be precise.

G.1 LEPC Yearly Training and Exercising Plan

By agreement, the Quad-County Hazardous Materials Response Team conducts five drills annually along with separate skills sessions. The purpose of these drills is to assure skill levels are maintained and the Team is functioning in accordance with each county's HAZMAT plan and the Quad-County Interlocal Agreement. The drills may consist of tabletop, functional, or full-scale exercises.

Exercising each county's HAZMAT plan will be the responsibility of that individual county and will occur annually in conjunction with the drills. The tentative schedule for the 2025 Quad-County Hazardous Materials Response Team's drills and skills sessions is as follows:

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Section 2-MSDS Available to Public & Annual Notice

The LEPC shall annually publish a notice in the Nevada Appeal advising that the Hazardous Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) or chemical inventory lists, and follow-up emergency notices are available for public review, consistent with Section 322 of the EPCRA. The public notice shall also state that follow-up emergency notices may be issued.

The public may review these documents during normal office hours at the Carson City Fire Department, Station 51, 777 S. Stewart St., Carson City, NV 89701.

Section 3-Public Request for Information

Any person may submit a written request for information to the LEPC under Section 311 (42 U.S.C. § 11021), 312 (42 U.S.C. § 110022), and 324 (42 U.S.C. § 11044) of EPCRA.

Requests shall be sent to the attention of the Carson City LEPC at the following address: Carson City Fire Department, Station 51, 777 S. Stewart St., Carson City, NV 89701. The LEPC shall respond to requests for information no later than 45 days from the receipt of request.

Section 4-Responsibility for LEPC Disclosures & Responses

The LEPC Chairperson, or the Chairperson's designee, shall serve as the LEPC coordinator for disclosures and responses required by this Article.

ARTICLE IX-Amendments

These bylaws shall be reviewed annually at any regular or special meeting of the LEPC and may be amended or replaced upon the affirmative vote of a quorum of the LEPC members.

ARTICLE X-Dissolution

In the event that the SERC dissolves the LEPC or the LEPC otherwise becomes inactive, the LEPC's operations and obligations shall revert to the SERC.
