Narrative of use of Hazardous Materials Plan

The functional drill used the following elements of the hazardous materials plan: Hazard Classifications, ICS system structure on Hazmat Incidents, ERG review, decontamination line setup, Level A and B suit donning/doffing, and team integration with bomb squad personnel.

The practical exercise was designed to integrate the Quad County haz-mat team with outside agency personnel. The design allowed for multiple entries of both Tahoe Douglas Bomb Squad (TDBS) personnel and quad county team members. Additionally, the Douglas County Sheriff Office (DCSO) was represented through a member of their evidence collection team to provide practical application of evidence collection and chain of custody through the decontamination process.

The scenario was as follows: The drill was located at the George Whittell High School with the location simulation a multiple unit building where an illegal lab was located. The initial entry by local response units noticed the potential for this being an improvised explosive lab so they contacted haz-mat and TDBS units. The overarching objectives were to render safe any explosive elements, transition to the haz-mat team, and evidence collection through a level A entry and subsequent decontamination of personnel and evidence.

The Quad County haz-mat team and the TDBS integrated upon simulated arrival on scene and made operational decisions through a unified command. Entry of a bomb technician in full level B, SCBA, and bomb squad was undertaken for simulated render safe procedures of explosive element. Full decontamination line was implemented with this TDBS member being decontaminated by the Quad County team. Once this member was able to debrief the team, the objective switched to evidence collection of the chemical components with a two-member team from Quad County in level A suits. This team as well as observers were assisted by a DCSO evidence collection tech as to proper handling, collection, packaging, and decontamination of the evidence. During these operations, all team members utilized ERG and other relevant reference materials as well as 4 gas, 5 gas, and appropriate paper arrays for recognition and safe operations. All entry members went through full decontamination line at end of their operations.

Prior to the practical drill mentioned above, all members of the teams received an hour-long presentation on bomb squad operations, evidence collection, and integration of specialty units in a haz-mat response setting. The combination of this presentation and then practical application of this united effort allowed for excellent training as to unified command and working with units not normally operating with.

Narrative of Corrective Actions

While there were no major deficiencies noted, there are areas for improvement. The integration of multiple specialty units is an area that needs to be trained upon regularly. While the objectives were met for the drill, the communication and operational ease were strained at times. The ability to work together seamlessly relies of continual training and information sessions between these teams. Understanding each other's equipment, communication equipment and style, as well as Standard Operating Procedures is important for a safe and effective operation. Moving forward, it is recommended to continue these types of drills and trainings while including more outlying agencies to include, but not limited to, the 92nd Civil Support Team (CST) and law enforcement in more traditional roles such as traffic control and scene security.
